1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

- 1.1. The Macleay D.M.C.C hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct 28th Akubra Classic for Solo's - Senior & Juniors, ATV's and Sidecars at the Greenhill Speedway, on 25th & 26th August 2018

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The above-mentioned open meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number PERMIT NUMBER and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.
- 2.2. Day Licenses will be accepted, riders must request application form via email to the Race Secretary.
- 2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.
- 2.4. **BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close 10th August 2018
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the online entry form at www.racesecretary.com and accompanied by the correct fee being forwarded to the clubs bank account will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE: LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED OR REJECTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE RACE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE OR CLUB EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.**

4. **INSURANCE:**

- 4.1. National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.
- 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.**

JUNIORS

Trophies will be awarded between for all junior classes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.
All 50cc Demonstration riders will all receive an award of the same or equal value.

10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

10.1. To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be

Solo's: 8 riders

Sidecars: 4 riders

ATV's: 5 riders

50cc Division 1 & 2 minimum of 6 riders and a maximum of 12 riders.

10.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prize money, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.

11. RACE FORMAT:

11.1. Where there are 12 riders or more.

There will be 3 rounds of qualifying heats of 4 laps

Riders finishing 1st to 10th in the heats will progress to the Final

Riders finishing 11th to 22nd after the qualifying heats will contest the repechage.

1 repechage of 5 laps

1st and 2nd in the repechage will progress to the final

1 final of 6 laps.

The Akubra Solo Classic Final held over 10 laps.

11.2. Where there are less than 12 riders the class will be run over 5 rounds of 4 laps

11.3. **SIDECAR and ATV**

Where there are 6 riders or more

There will be 3 rounds of qualifying heats of 4 laps

Riders finishing 1st to 5th in the heats will progress to the final

Riders finishing 6th to 11th after the qualifying heats will contest the repechage.

1st and 2nd in the repechage will progress to the Final

1 repechage of 5 laps

1 final of 6 laps

11.4. Where there are less than 6 riders the class will be run over 5 rounds of 4 laps

12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for *Dirt Track* competition.

12.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

12.3. Change of machine is not permitted

12.4. Noise &/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.

13. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1. Competitors will be allocated their Motorcycling NSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred riding number if available. All others shall be allocated numbers at the Promoter's discretion.
- 13.2. All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

14. GRID POSITIONS:

- 14.1. Grid positions will be pre-drawn and printed in the program.
- 14.2. Grid positions for the repechages/finals will be chosen by the highest point scorer having first choice & so on

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and all participants MUST attend. Riders' briefing sign-on sheets must be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance.

16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

17. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behavior at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

- 18.1. For the purposes of drug & alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7.00am both days with the completion of the meeting for the participant being at the completion of racing.

19. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

The circuit length is 560 meters and constructed of oiled loam. Racing is anti-clockwise.

Entry to this area is strictly for officials and competitors of the event in places.

Entry to all others is prohibited unless authorized by the clerk of course.

20. STARTS:

Self-penalizing gates

21. RACING:

Each rider will receive 2 laps practice Saturday.

No practice Sunday

Racing as per race format in point 11.

22. NOISE:

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's and the track licence.

23. PAYG WITHOUT HOLDING:

The Pay As You Go Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter may withhold 47% of prize money over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize moneys paid to you.

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 24.1 Presentations etc. Will be advised at Riders Briefing Sunday
- 24.2 Facilities: Full Canteen facilities will be available on the day.
- 24.3 Tyres: Tyres; Knobbly tyres are not permitted on any machine over 50cc
- 24.4 Admission Charges: Adults \$10 per day. Children 12yrs + \$10 per day. Children under 12yrs Free.
- 24.5 Camping at Track **NO CAMPING onsite, camping is available at Kempsey showground**
- 24.6 Off Limits The score tower is OFF limits with the exception of the OFFICIALS of the meeting
- 24.7 Pit Area: Children under the age of 16 are not permitted in the pit/paddock area unless they are a competitor. All persons entering the pit /paddock area must be wearing enclosed footwear.
- 24.8 Sign on All Contact to Participate Declaration forms to be signed at Sign-on. If a temporary guardian ship form is required please fill one out and bring to sign on.
